Two brothers once set out walking together and came upon a stone by the roadside. On it were carved the words: *“He who takes this road will find happiness, but first he will know hunger, cold, and weariness.”* The older brother read it and said, “Why should we risk suffering when we have all we need at home?” The younger brother looked at the same words and felt his heart stir. “If happiness lies ahead,” he said, “I will endure whatever comes.” So they parted—one returning to the familiar, the other stepping into the unknown.

The younger brother wandered through forests and mountains, sleeping under open skies, working for food, and learning the ways of strangers. Hardship followed him, but so did unexpected kindness.
